

Laser Sailboat with 4.7 Rig (all necessary parts) and Standard Rig (all necessary parts with 2 sails!): \$975

I bought this laser sailboat off Craig's List 3 years ago and have had a wonderful time sailing her around Great Harbor, down past the ferry dock, and to Devil's Foot Island. She is not in Olympic racing condition but she's ready to take out on the water as is and have fun. Suited mostly for solo sailing but perfectly ok with two folks and a few beers in light enough wind.

The 4.7 rig (for smaller folks like me or for prudent sailors in higher winds) includes a bottom mast section and a sail, both of which I bought new in 2013. The standard rig includes an older bottom mast (came with boat) and two older sails which are both in good condition. I refinished the wood dagger board this year, so it's in good shape. The rudder is also wood. I also bought the tiller with extension new in 2013 and it's in excellent condition. Of course, the boom and top mast are also included. I do not have a dolly but was able to keep it on the public beach by the Woods Hole Yacht Club for the last 3 summers (which you would also likely be able to do). All required lines (main sheet, outhaul, downhaul, etc.) are included.

If you are interested, there is also a group of locals and WHOI folks who have started a laser racing fleet in the spring and fall, which I could put you in touch with. For everything included, \$975 is an insanely good price, especially with the several practically new components.
