Marine Environmental Scientist Faculty Position

December 2014: Sea Education Association (SEA), www.sea.edu invites applications for a permanent full-time 9-month faculty position at the assistant or associate professor level in Marine Environmental Sciences. We are a non-profit educational institution located in Woods Hole, Massachusetts, teaching innovative and rigorous oceanography and environmental science programs on our campus in Woods Hole, and aboard our state-of-the-art sailing research vessels, *SSV Corwith Cramer* and *SSV Robert C. Seamans* in the Atlantic and Pacific Oceans. The undergraduate semester courses consist of intensive classroom instruction complemented by a 4-7 week research cruise to execute independent student research. Teaching responsibilities include two semester courses and selected seminar programs each year with up to 14 weeks at sea in the role of Chief Scientist. The position is based in Woods Hole (Falmouth), MA.

The successful candidate will pursue a professional agenda of innovative interdisciplinary teaching and excellent scholarship, and possess the desire to join and contribute to a deeply committed educational community. Successful applicants will be expected to teach courses on a variety of topics including oceanography, marine environmental history, climate change, biodiversity, marine biology, marine ecology, oceanographic methods, and also supervise independent research projects. A Ph.D. in a natural science is required with extensive field experience desired.

A review of applications will begin February 15, 2015, and will continue until the position is filled. Applicants should submit a cover letter, curriculum vitae, one-page statement of teaching philosophy, and the names and contact information for three professional references.
