Leave Plymouth Harbor and travel offshore to observe the unique marine wildlife found off New England. Sail aboard the "Tails of the Sea", a luxury 110' whale-watching vessel owned and operated by Captain John Boats. Leave from the Town Pier in Plymouth at 8 AM sharp and return to the dock by 6 PM that evening.

Wayne Peterson and David Clapp from Mass Audubon will be onboard providing commentary on seabirds sighted offshore. Dr. John Jahoda from Bridgewater State College will provide commentary on the whales and pelagic fish sighted during the trip. Good food will be available for purchase including Dunkin Donut bagels and donuts, gourmet coffee, and veggie or meat wraps from Stop & Shop. Or bring your own food onboard, but no alcohol or glass is allowed.

Tickets are \$75. **Don't wait!** The number of passengers is limited to ensure a comfortable ride offshore.
