- Nov. 28 Video: Science of the Deep The Wreck of the Portland, a special one-hour program in high definition video from The Science Channel *Commentary*: Matthew Lawrence and Deborah Marx, sanctuary maritime archaeologists will discuss shipwrecks of the sanctuary
- **Dec. 12 Video: Ocean Adventures Voyage to Kure, Part 1**, an exploration of the islands, atolls, and submarine features of the nation's new Northwestern Hawaiian Islands Marine National Monument *Commentary*: Craig D. MacDonald, Ph.D., sanctuary superintendent, will recount stories from his research experiences at Kure Atoll
- **Dec. 26 Video:** Ocean Adventures Voyage to Kure, Part 2, the voyage to the far reaches of the Northwestern Hawaiian Islands culminates at Kure *Commentary*: Craig D. MacDonald, Ph.D., sanctuary superintendent, will continue his entertaining tales from the NW Hawaiian Islands

- Jan. 9 Video: Ocean Adventures Sharks at Risk, a close-up look at this fascinating but often misunderstood group of animals *Commentary*: Carol Carson, naturalist and educator, will report on a new program to identify basking sharks in the sanctuary
- Jan. 23 Video: Ocean Adventures America's Underwater Treasures, Pt 1, a tour of the sanctuaries starts with visits to the Florida Keys, Channel Islands, Flower Garden Banks and Olympic Coast *Commentary*: Ben Cowie-Haskell, assistant superintendent, will review his work on the Tortugas Ecological Reserve in the Florida Keys NMS
- Feb. 6 Video: Ocean Adventures America's Underwater Treasures, Pt 2, the tour continues with visits to Stellwagen Bank and Monterey Bay *Commentary*: Ben Cowie-Haskell, asst. superintendent, will relate his experiences diving with the Cousteau film crew on Stellwagen Bank
- Feb 20 Video: Ocean Adventures The Grey Whale Obstacle Course, follows the migration of these west coast giants

  Commentary: Leila Hatch, Ph.D., sanctuary acoustics specialist, will provide highlights from recent whale research missions in the sanctuary
- Mar. 6 Video: Game Warden TV: Stellwagen Bank, provides an inside look at resource protection programs in the sanctuary

  Commentary: Anne Smrcina, education coordinator, will provide tips on safe boating around whales from the sanctuary's See A Spout program
