The MassDEP Circuit Rider Program is pleased to present the next in a series of **free** educational workshops for Conservation Commission members, staff, and other interested persons.

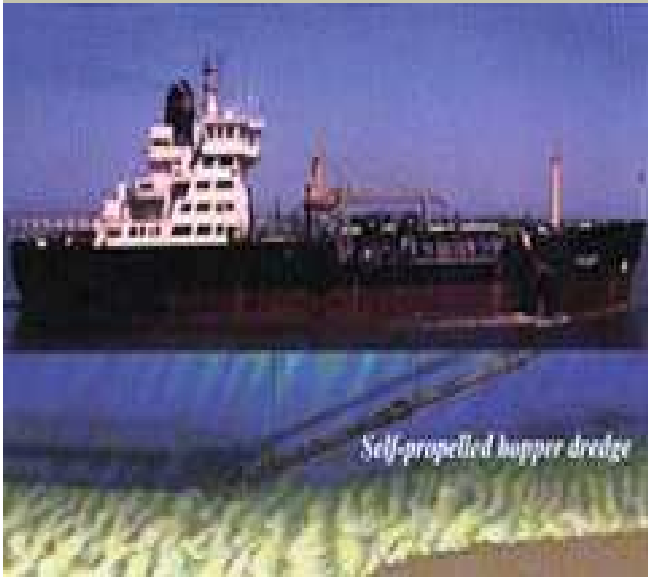
