Directions To PCCS Marine Lab at 5 Holway Avenue:

- Take Route 6 towards Provincetown.
- From Rt. 6 take a left at the Conwell Street Exit (it has a stop light and is your second "entrance" to Provincetown.
- At the end of Conwell Street, turn right onto Bradford Street.
- Go approximately one mile, and at the top of the hill (just before the Crowne Point Inn), take a right on Prince Street.
- $\hbox{-} \ \, \text{Take your first right at the parking booth (town-paid parking lot)}. \ \, \text{Drive straight towards the stop sign.}$
- $\operatorname{\sf Turn}$ Left. Park at the farthest end of the lot, across from the high school.
- The marine lab is the building BEHIND the church parish hall. It cannot be seen from the parking lot.
