# Themes for Summer 2013

## **July 1<sup>st</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> Explore, Discover, And Create!**

Gather inspiration as we discover Long Pasture's woods, wetlands, fields, beaches and salt marshes on our 110 acre sanctuary. Create clay butterflies in the fields and meadows, paint at the ponds, design from nature under the giant holly trees and use the beach as a canvas for spectacular sand art.

## **July 8<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> Survivor Cape Cod - The Second Season**

Can you spot tiny prey from afar like a hawk, camouflage to escape a predator or stalk silently like a Wampanoag? Can you find a meal or mate with just your sense of smell or build a shelter from the storm? See if you have what it takes to survive in the wild world!

## **July 15<sup>th</sup> – 19<sup>th</sup> Tide's Out!**

Moon snails, horseshoe crabs, mud snails, worms, crustaceans and mollusks make their home in the tidal flats on Cape Cod. When the tide goes out so will we! Onto the tidal flats to search and reveal who makes their homes in the muck, sand and tide pools. Prepare to be amazed at the creatures that survive in an environment flooded by the tides twice a day!

## **July 22<sup>nd</sup> – 26<sup>th</sup> EGGS-cellent EGG-ventures!**

Egg cases on the beach, eggs under logs, bird eggs and butterfly eggs on the branches. Let's do some EGGS-xploring and possibly some EGGS-xperiments while discovering the variety of habitats containing eggs and creatures that develop from eggs in the vast variety of sanctuary ecosystems.

## **July 29<sup>th</sup> – August 2<sup>nd</sup> Who Goes There?**

Let's take a hike and become nature detectives! Searching for animal signs and evidence will become our mission as we explore Long Pasture's spectacular sanctuary. Using our powers of observation we will become trackers, discovering where animals have been and what animals have been eating in the woods, meadows, marshes and beaches of Mass Audubon.

## **August 5<sup>th</sup> – 9<sup>th</sup> Get Your Goat!**

Are you kidding? Hike with our young Nigerian Dwarf goats and see the world from a goat's eyes. Meet dairy cows Mabel and Olive and discover how grass becomes milk and cow pies. Are you a locavore? Check out our organic gardens and chomp on some veggies fresh from the earth.

## **August 12<sup>th</sup> – 16<sup>th</sup> Ocean In Motion**

Ever wonder what's down under? Discover sea life from scallops to seals and plunge to the bottom of deep questions such as "Why is the ocean salty and not sweet?" Prepare to have the coolest answers ever when asked, "What did you do over summer vacation?"
