



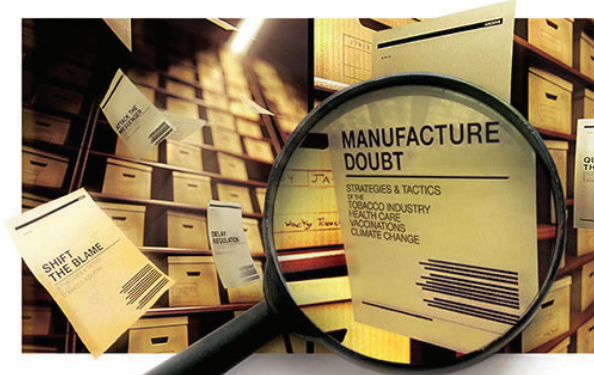

Facts: Permafrost contains almost twice as much carbon as the atmosphere. Carbon emissions from thawing permafrost accelerate climate warming and create a self-perpetuating cycle of further warming and thawing. Climate models currently don't account for carbon emissions from thawing permafrost. Permafrost thaw is irreversible. Learn how these significant discoveries will impact *you*.
