Marine Science Instructor Job Description

Bourne Community Boating seeks a part-time, seasonal science instructor for our Belly Biology Marine Science program in the summer of 2016. Primary responsibility is to plan and lead instruction for once per week Belly Biology classes, building on existing lesson plans and partner organization programs. The successful candidate will need to work well with Belly Biology partner organizations who teach some classes, and to take the lead and be the primary instructor for other classes. The candidate must be willing to be flexable, adaptable and maintain a sense of humor as they work outdoors with our students, sailing instructor staff, Executive Director, and partner organizations.

Background: Marine Science instruction has been an important part of BCB's Learn to Sail curriculum since our start in 2006. From the beginning, one of our stated goals has been to create not only good sailors, but also good stewards of the environment in which they sail. All Beginner, Advanced Beginner and Intermediate sailors spend one day per week of their sailing program studying a variety of Marine Science topics in our program called Belly Biology.

Training and Experience:

Required:

- Minimum of a Bachelor degree in science or education
- Previous lead teaching experience in an outdoor or marine science setting Preferred:
 - First Aid, CPR, Lifeguard, US Sailing Level 1 or USCG license.

Organization: Bourne Community Boating, Inc, (BCB), a 501(c)3 public charity, was founded in 2006 and its mission is: "To provide an opportunity to people of all ages, abilities and background to enrich their lives through on-the-water educational and recreational experiences." BCB especially tries to reach the year-round, full-time resident youth population of Bourne, many of whom would not have had the opportunity to learn to sail without BCB's programs. BCB works to introduce these students to sailing, boating and marine science in a friendly, fun and inclusive environment. BCB's primary program is an 8-week long youth summer sailing and marine science school. In addition, BCB offers Adult Sailing, Adaptive Sailing, Paddleboarding, and Open Sailing.
