She teaches for New England Wild Flower Society, NOFA, the Ecologic Landscaping Alliance and other organizations.

Ellen will talk about the vital connections between native plants and pollinators and other insects that rely on their existence, and will introduce some beautiful native plants suited for the varying conditions found on Cape Cod.
