The Abandoned House

The Nye Family Association will present the first of a winter series of History Talks at the Grange Hall on Sunday, January 28th, 2:00-3:00 p.m. at 91 Old County Road, East Sandwich. “**The Abandoned House**” slide talk will present the history of an early 18th century East Sandwich farmhouse with an unusual photographic portrayal of its life and demise after abandonment in the early 1950s. The photographs span over 100 years. Presenter John Nye Cullity, executive director of the Nye Family of America Association, Inc. photographed the house from 1966 through 1988. Over this period the house was slowly dismantled, revealing early construction details.
