Eyes on Owls: A Live Owl Show!

Saturday! April 7th at 10am and 1pm



Westport, Massachusetts – Presenting Eyes on Owls – A LIVE Owl Show! on Saturday, April 7th at the Westport Junior/Senior high school. Attendees are in for a fun hooting lesson and close-up views of these secretive birds of prey! The Westport Land Conservation Trust is pleased to present their fifth annual live owl show. Two shows: 10am and 1pm.

Naturalists Mark and Marcia Wilson will present the live owls one at a time with each owl perched securely on Marcia's gloved hand. The owls presented have permanent disabilities which prevent them from surviving on their own in the wild. These non-releasable owls are captivating ambassadors from the world of wildlife.



All the owls are legally permitted by state and federal agencies for use in environmental educational programs. Tickets are \$10 for adults, \$5 for children ages 5-11. (This program is not recommended for children under 5.)
