Westport Land Conservation Trust and The Trustees partner to host the annual Super Bowl Walk

On Super Bowl Sunday, February 2, 2020, starting at 11:00 am, the Westport Land Conservation Trust (WLCT) and The Trustees will be hosting their annual Super Bowl Walk, a hike that extends from the Slocums River in Dartmouth to the Westport River in Westport.

Conservation efforts in the area make it possible to do this 6+ mile hike. Here's your chance to experience sections of trail not normally open to the public--and get a little fresh air before watching the Super Bowl! For a special treat, the Westport Rivers Winery will be opening its doors to greet hikers at the end of the walk with discounted wine and beer by the glass only for \$7 and 20% off all take home wine for hikers, whether it is one bottle or many.

The walk will begin at 11 a.m. at the Slocum's River Reserve parking area across from 253 Horseneck Road in Dartmouth, about 1.4 miles south of Russells Mills Village.
