Details:

The Summer Oceanography Seminar will introduce students to practical methods in ocean water sampling and analysis. Led by Jim Remillard, Science Department Chair for Saint John Paul II High School in Hyannis, participants will:

- Learn how to use gear and instrumentation to collect water samples and measure parameters such as temperature, salinity, oxygen, and pH.
- Develop skills to format spreadsheets & create charts from the data collected in the field
- Perform daily plankton tows
- Identify and photograph plankton
- Prepare and present their work to their families and the public during an outdoor evening program at the Cape Cod Canal Visitor Center.
