#### Overview:

- Experience as Head Instructor in a Sailing or similar summer camp setting
- Experience with small boat repair and maintenance, including troubleshooting, fiberglass repairs, basic outboard upkeep, trailering, and coordination with vendors.
- Experience with managing a staff of 5-8 young adults
- US Sailing Level 1 or higher Instructor certification
- Current First Aid/CPR certifications, at a minimum
- Excellent organizational and communication skills
- Ability to work well independently and with diverse groups
- Exhibit a mature, professional demeanor
- Ability to manage multiple challenges at the same time
