RESPONSIBILITIES:

The Park Interpreter provides customer service and resource interpretation for visitors. Tasks include: visitor information and orientation, presenting programs that reflect the natural, cultural and historical stories of the park, coordinating special events and programs with public or private organizations.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Applicants must be at least eighteen years old, possess a basic knowledge of natural and cultural history, have experience working with the public, possess solid communications skills, have the ability to follow oral and written instructions, and the ability to work in a team setting. Current driver's license and reliable transportation required.

EMPLOYMENT INFORMATION:

Seasonal Park Interpreters work a forty-hour week (which includes weekends, holidays, and possibly evenings). Starting salary is \$14.25/hour. Uniforms and training are provided. Park housing is not provided.
