

The deep waters of the ocean, or the midwaters, is one of the largest ecosystems on our planet, yet remains one of the least explored. Little-known marine animals that inhabit these waters have developed life strategies that contribute to their success, and may inspire engineering solutions for terrestrial life. Although significant advances in underwater technologies have improved access to this region, small-scale, behavioral observations of individual animals continue to be challenging.
